The University of Saint Francis basketball program has enjoyed tremendous success in the Mid-Central Conference and National recognition.

Basketball Camp Director

Jeff Rekeweg, three-time MCC Coach of the Year, just ended his thirteenth season at the helm of the Cougars. Rekeweg has taken a program that had seen some success to a perennial nationally rated team. The 1999-2000 season the Cougars finished the season ranked #1 Nationally and finished 31-6. Coach Rekeweg has developed seven All-Americans and one National Player of the Year in his twelve years at Saint Francis.

Rekeweg is an excellent communicator, who uses discipline and enthusiasm to motivate his players. He stresses fundamentals and execution for his high-pressure defense and up-tempo offense. He knows what it takes to build a prosperous program having coached and played in successful collegiate programs. He has brought with him a wealth of knowledge and experience to the Hutzell Athletic Center hard-court. A native of Auburn, IN and a graduate of DeKalb High School, Rekeweg finished his college-playing career at the University of Nebraska, where he earned a business degree.

Rekeweg was the only Husker during his senior year to start every game and he led his team in Free throw percentage and was second in field goal percentage.

Following his collegiate career, Rekeweg played professionally in Europe. His final stop was in California playing in the summer Pro-Am League in Los Angeles.

Rekeweg's coaching career began at DeKalb High School at the freshman level. After one season at DeKalb, Rekeweg ventured to Danville Area Community College as an assistant coach.

Rekeweg resides in Fort Wayne with his wife Rebecca, and their five daughters.
