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- You will need to earn 60 hours to be considered a sophomore. Please take this into account when registering.
 - Do not forget about your sophomore review during your second year.
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- After you complete six semesters, you must have your senior audit. Please discuss this with your advisor, this is a graduation requirement and you will need to complete this to ensure you have the credits and hours to graduate in the eighth semester.
