APPLICANT'S AGREEMENT

In order to induce the Trustee and/or Scholarship Committee to consider the undersigned for a grant and in consideration of the granting of same, but with no obligation on the Trustee' and/or Scholarship Committee to do so, the undersigned agrees as follows:

In the event a grant is made pursuant to this application, then on or before ninety days after the end of the academic period for which scholarship is granted, the undersigned will furnish the Trustee with a financial report and accounting evidencing to the Trustee's satisfaction, that the undersigned has satisfactorily completed and achieved the activities for which such scholarship was awarded and that there was no improper diversion of scholarship money for which it was intended. As a condition to the granting of the scholarship, undersigned further agrees to reimburse the Trust, along with reasonable costs of collection, attorney fees and interest to the extent that any of such scholarship money is not used by undersigned to satisfactorily perform and achieve the activities for which such scholarship was intended, or to the extent undersigned improperly diverts any of such scholarship money from the use for which it was intended.
