

As the university community is always eager to learn about our students' career outcomes post-graduation, each year we gather information regarding where our new graduates are applying their skills upon leaving USF. University data demonstrates that approximately 95 percent of our USF graduates immediately begin employment, enroll in advanced studies, or enlist in service or military, while some still may be seeking the right opportunity.

No matter their individual outcomes, our data collection efforts are helping to demonstrate that USF has built a network of alumni who economically, socially and spiritually contribute to society. These positive results show that a University of Saint Francis education gives our students an excellent chance for personal and professional success after graduation.








ABOUT THE DATA

The university conducted a data collection effort for the Class of 2019 graduates to determine their career and educational outcomes after graduation. The Class of 2019 includes students who graduated between July 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019.

Data was gathered until December 31, 2019, for 578 of the 629 graduates, yielding a knowledge rate of 91.9%. Knowledge rate refers to the percentage of graduates for whom knowledge of their career outcomes has been obtained. This includes survey data provided by students, social media profile information, National Student Clearinghouse enrollment data and knowledge shared from academic departments.

Gathering this information is a requirement of the Higher Education Opportunity Act, but this data can also assist students and families in understanding the types of career and educational opportunities that are possible with a USF degree. More importantly, however, this data provides insight to area businesses, organizations and graduate schools about the University of Saint Francis record of producing quality talent.
