



## USF Yellow Ribbon Match

### *Eligibility Criteria*

Students who qualify for Post 9-11 VA Benefits and participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program will receive a matching grant from USF. Students may renew this grant as long as they maintain a 2.0 GPA and remain in good Academic Standing to receive Financial Aid. There are 100 Undergraduate grants available. There are additionally 10 Graduate grants in School of Professional Studies, Keith Busse School of Business, School of Creative Arts and School of Arts and Sciences.

### *Award Amount*

Students will be granted half of the remaining tuition and fees after the VA Benefit amount (\$27,120.05 for the 2023-2024 academic year). This may not be combined with other institutional financial aid, which is also limited to tuition and fees. Instead, they will receive the remainder of their tuition and fees paid (half by Yellow Ribbon and half by USF).
