# **Ultrasound Student Assessment (USA)**

Instructions for Testing with the University of Saint Francis

## **Requirements for the USA Exam**

- ✓ Student must have a Windows operating system on their computer
  - o The USA exam will not work on a MAC, Chromebook, tablet, phone
- ✓ Student must use external mouse, cannot use touchpad
- ✓ A physical keyboard is recommended, not a digital keyboard
- ✓ Picture ID
  - Student ID, driver's license, passport, etc.
- ✓ Web Cam
  - Proctor will observe remotely during testing

### **Students Ready to Schedule Exam**

- ✓ Testing Availability: Monday-Friday, 10am 4pm EST
- ✓ Students have two options to Schedule:
  - o Call Pegasus Lectures at 972-564-3056, Mon Friday 10am-6pm EST
  - o Online Link: Pegasus Lectures USA Exam
    - \*Must include to add the proctoring option
- ✓ Payment in the amount of \$70.00 (*includes proctoring fee*) will be required
  - O Visa, MC, AMEX or Discover are acceptable forms of payment
  - USF is a College Partner
- ✓ Student will receive an email from Pegasus Lectures after payment to schedule their exam.

#### Students Ready to Take Exam

- ✓ On Test Day:
  - Student will receive an email prior to testing time with a link for the proctor to connect to your computer -- follow the instructions on the email
  - Student may need to input this info at the beginning of the test

  - Testing time is generally 1 2 hours, but there is **no time limit**
- ✓ After Test:
  - Students will not receive their scores immediately upon completion of the exam and please do not contact Pegasus Lectures for scores.
