


## IPEDS Overall Cohort 150% Graduation Rate, 5-year History<sup>1</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> IPEDS overall cohort 150% graduation rate is also known as the "Student Right-to-Know Act" or IPEDS graduation rate; it tracks the progress of students who began their studies as full-time, first-time degree seeking or certificate seeking students to see if they complete a degree or other award such as a certificate within 150% of "normal time" for completing the program in which they are enrolled (e.g., associate degree in three years; bachelor's degree in six years)
