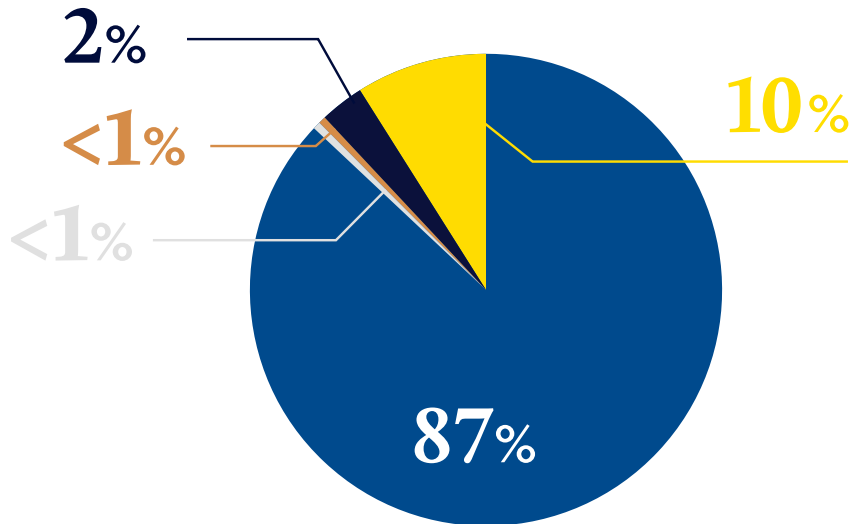

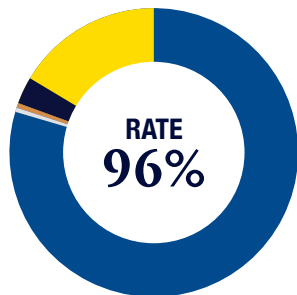

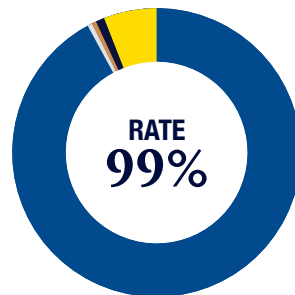

ABOUT THE DATA

The university conducted a data collection effort for the Class of 2024 graduates to determine their career and educational outcomes after graduation. The Class of 2024 includes students who graduated between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024.

Data was gathered through December 31, 2024, for 547 of the 587 graduates, yielding a knowledge rate of 93%. Knowledge rate refers to the percentage of graduates for whom knowledge of their career outcomes has been obtained. This includes survey data provided by students, social media profile information, National Student Clearinghouse enrollment data and knowledge shared by Saint Francis faculty and staff.

Gathering this information is a requirement of the Higher Education Opportunity Act, but this data can also assist students and families in understanding the types of career and educational opportunities that are possible with a Saint Francis degree. This data provides insight to area businesses, organizations and graduate schools about the University of Saint Francis record for producing quality talent.
